Do you or someone you know have a child that is interested in playing hockey for the first time?

NOW IS THE TIME FOR THEM TO SIGN UP FOR HOCKEY!!

Thanks to a generous grant from the Gretzky Foundation, the BVAA is able to offer first time hockey players a subsidy that will cover the majority of their hockey registration fee.

Equipment may also be available for new hockey registrants to use.

To take advantage of this all you have to do is register for the 2010-2011 hockey season. First time registrants may register on-line with no late fee. They are requested not to pay online. The amount of the subsidy is yet to be determined and all eligible hockey players will be notified in advance of their payment deadline which will be June 30th.

New registrants, like all members, will be required to do a minimum of 10 hours of fundraising/volunteering for the BVAA, thus will still be subject to the \$250 bond check.

If your child or a child you know would like to give hockey a try now is the time to do it! As with all players, a commitment to their team to attend practices and games is required. GIRLS HOCKEY

Thornbury registered girls hockey parents agreed unanimously this week to pool our girls teams with Meaford girls teams for the 201/2011 season. There will be one entry with the OWHA and it will be the Georgian Shores girls hockey team. Without the pooling of teams there would only have been a Beaver Valley Atom girls team; and Meaford would only have been able to offer Bantam and Midget girls hockey.

Registering with the BVAA and then pooling the teams for OWHA registration with Meaford is initially set for one year, for a trial and honours the by-laws by having hockey offered by the BVAA. It does set the stage for a strong and sustainable girls hockey program. By pooling together for this year, OWHA teams will be offered at the Atom level to the Intermediate level, with two teams being offered at the Bantam and Midget level.

We have a few options for offering Intermediate girls hockey, it would be helpful if we had a few more intermediate girls signed up though, so if you are born in 1991 or 1992 and want to continue to play hockey, sign up today or call Carla Nicolson at 519 599 1158.

If we get a few more girls at the Atom level we may be in a position to offer two teams, really the critical link to be able to offer hockey at the appropriate skill level. So, if you know of someone who was born in 2000 or 2001, please encourage them to sign up today.
